## WILLUM WARRAIN CODE OF CONDUCT FOR EVENTS, AGM and MEETINGS

- 1. All Willum Warrain members shall conduct themselves in a professional manner, showing respect and care to all other event, AGM and meeting participants.
- 2. All people are to respect and acknowledge each other's right to speak and be heard without interruptions.
- 3. Every person is entitled to their own view, whether or not you agree with it.
- 4. At AGM and meetings, all questions and comments are to be made through the chairperson.
- 5. At AGM meetings, people should try and keep their comments focussed on the agenda items, and respect the chairperson's directions to keep the meeting on track.
- 6. Physical or verbal abuse or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated. Anybody considered to be acting in this manner will be requested to leave the event, AGM or meeting.

Any member found to have breached the Willum Warrain Code of Conduct may have their membership cancelled.
